# COLLECTION AND DROP OFF OF CHILDREN: SCHOOL HOURS: Mon-Thu 07:30 to 14:15, Friday 07:30 to 12:00.

**AFTERCARE HOURS:** Mon-Thu 14: 15 to 12:00 to 17:30, Friday 12:00 to 17:30.

Children are to be dropped off at the middle gate on Sentinel's property in the morning where they will be greeted and then walk on their own to their class.

Collection of children in the afternoon will be at the main gate on Sentinel's property, where your children will wait with their teachers.

NO Parents are allowed to come onto the school premises after 08:00 in the morning. No vehicles are permitted on the school property at any time.

**LATE COLLECTION**: Please note, any child not collected on time will be charged R10 per 5 minutes late and your child will not be allowed into the school the next morning if the penalty is not paid. This applies for both school and aftercare collections.

**SAYING HELLO AND GOODBYE**: Please hug and kiss your child when saying hello and goodbye! It is SO important for them to feel loved®

#### **COMMUNICATION:**

Please do not hesitate to contact us should you need to. We are here for you and your child.

MESSAGE BOOKS: Your child will receive a message book. This book is used for us to communicate with you and vice-versa. All notices etc. will be placed in the book. Please check your child's book each day. The book belongs to the school and must be returned should your child leave the school.

CHANGE OF CONTACT DETAILS: Please inform us if your contact details change. We need to have a working cell no in order to communicate with you.

#### **GRADE 1 APPLICATIONS:**

Grade 1 applications for 2019 open on 5
Feb 2018 and close on 28 March 2018. If
you want your child to get a place in
Grade 1 please make sure you apply to all
the schools early. This is your responsibility
as a parent to make sure your child is
registered, not ours!

TRACK SUITS and T-SHIRTS: Branded school clothing is available on order. Track suits: R180. Short sleeved bright yellow T-shirts: R50.00. Long sleeved T-shirts: R60.

BACK PACKS: Children are to use the yellow back packs for school only.

MEALS: Breakfast & Lunch are included. Your child must please bring a fruit to share each day. Please advise us of any food allergies your child may have.

#### ATTENDANCE/ILLNESS:

It is very important for your child to be at school every day of the week. Should your child be ill, please let us know via WhatsApp. If your child is ill for more than 2 days, a Dr's certificate is required.

**<u>BEDTIME</u>**: Please make sure your child goes to bed early and does not watch too much TV. Also be aware of what he/she is watching on TV.

**BRIBING:** Please do not bribe your children to come to school!

**SHARING:** Please encourage your children to share. This is a necessary life skill.

#### DISCIPLINE AT THE SCHOOL AND AT HOME:

Positive incentive systems are in place to encourage children to function at their expected level of performance with our **DO NO HARM POLICY**.

Parents and teachers will work together towards the child's behavior and modify it as and where necessary.

Parents and teachers will aspire to set a positive example to the young children in respect of developing attitudes and values towards self-management and conflict resolution appropriate to children of this young age.

Firm boundaries of discipline and expectation will be in place in a manner appropriate to children of a young age.

#### **INJURY:**

The school staff will, to the best of their ability, ensure the safety and well-being of all children in their care at all times.

The necessary first aid will be administered to a child in the event of minor injuries (every day scrapes and scratches).

Parents will be informed immediately of any injury of a more serious nature (broken bones, stitches etc) by the Principal, Administrator or teacher.

#### **ILLNESS AND MEDICATION**

A child who is ill must be kept at home. If a child becomes unwell at school during the day, the parents will be contacted in order for the child to be collected and treated accordingly. This is the parents' responsibility.

NO medication will be administered to children at school unless the child has a life threatening condition.

NO MEDICATION IS TO BE PLACED IN THE CHILD'S BAG FOR SELF MEDICATION.

<u>IOYS:</u> Do not allow your child to bring toys to school and if you see he/she has bought a toy from school to home, return it and discourage them from doing it again.

**RECYCLING:** Encourage your child to bring a bag of recycling to school on a Friday morning.

<u>WATER CRISIS</u>: As you know Cape Town is in a drought. Be very careful about water usage at home. We would also like each child to bring a 2lt bottle of recycled water to school each Friday, if possible.
